As most of you know, on January 27, 2004, my two-year-old nephew, Eric Carl Sjoblom, was diagnosed with stage IV of Neuroblastoma, an aggressive solid tumor cancer. After a courageous three-week fight, Eric lost his battle and passed away on Valentine's Day 2004. During this time, and after Eric's passing, we received tremendous financial and emotional support from The Tomorrow Fund at Hasbro Children's hospital. To pay it forward, we established The ECS Memorial Golf Tournament to raise money for this wonderful program. In Eric's memory, we have been able to provide some relief and support to other families who are battling childhood cancer. Your response to our annual tournament over the past 19 years has been both overwhelming and inspiring. With your continued support we have raised over \$250,000 for the Tomorrow Fund and plan to keep it going.
